



ORTHOPEDIC IMPAIRMENT ADDED AUTHORIZATION (OI AA) A CTC-accredited online course you can complete in one school year!

PROGRAM BENEFITS AND FEATURES

- **Authorizes** the holder to conduct assessments and provide instruction and special education-related services to individuals with a primary disability of orthopedic impairment across the continuum of special education program options at the grade and age levels authorized by the prerequisite credential

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A Preliminary/Level 1 or Clear/Level 2 Education Specialist Credential, or an Education Specialist Intern Credential
- Access to students with eligibility of Orthopedic Impairment and Health Care plans.

The VCOE OI AA Program consists of three modules totaling 90 hours of online instruction, practica, fieldwork, and observations. Candidates are required to complete all three OI AA Program modules, in order (A, B, C). Upon satisfactory completion of all program requirements, candidates are recommended for the added authorization.
